

Commentary on the Gospel for Wed, Dec 31st 2014

Here we are on the last day of the year. “The old has passed away, behold, the new has come” (2Cor 5:17). John says that we are living on the last days and the last hours because so many antichrists have appeared. Antichrists are those who bring division and create troubles. If the days that had just passed, brought frustration, sufferings, divisions and broken relationships in our societies, villages, communities and families, then those days are the last days.
