

Commentary on the Gospel for Tue, Apr 17th 2012

“The wind blows wherever it pleases.” You cannot see the wind, you only see the effect it has on things: you see the leaves on the trees moving, you see waves of movement on the grass, or you see the awful destruction that a typhoon can cause. The Holy Spirit is called wind: the coming of the Spirit at Pentecost was likened to “a powerful wind from heaven” (Acts 2:1). You cannot see the Spirit, you can only see the effects on people who live by the Spirit.
