## First Reading: Jos 24:1-13

Joshua gathered together all the tribes of lsrael at Shechem, summoning their elders, their leaders, their judges and their officers. When they stood in ranks before God, Joshua addressed all the people: "Thus says the LorD, the God of lsrael: In times past your fathers, down to Terah, father of Abraham and Nahor, dwelt beyond the River and served other gods. But I brought your father Abraham from the region beyond the River and led him through the entire land of Canaan. I made his descendants numerous, and gave him Isaac. To Isaac I gave Jacob and Esau. To Esau I assigned the mountain region of Seir in which to settle, while Jacob and his
children went down o Egypt.

Then I sent Moses and Aaron, and smote Egypt with the prodigies which 1 wrought in her midst. Afterward $I$ led you out of Egypt, and when you reached the sea, the Egyptians pursued your fathers to the Red Sea with chariots and horsemen. Because they cried out to the LORD, he put darkness between your people and the Egyptians, upon whom he brought the sea so that it engulfed them. After you witressed what
did to Esypt, and dwelt a long time in the desert, I brought you in

They fought against you, but I delivered them into your power. You took possession of their land, and I destroyed them, the two kings of the Amorites, before you. Then Balak, son of Zippor, king of Moab, prepared to war against Israel. He summoned
Balame son of Beor. to curse your: but I would not listen to Balaam. On the contrary, he had to bless you, and I saved you from him. Once you crossed the Jordan and came to Jericho, the men of Jericho fought against you, but I delivered them also into your power. And I sent the hormets ahead of you that drove them (hle Amorites, Perizzites, Canaanites, Hitities, Girgashites, Hivites and Jebusites) out of your way; it was not your sword or your bow
